Tobias Castagna to become Head of the testing experts at the National Test Institute for Cybersecurity NTC

Zug, 10/31/2022 – With start-up financing from the Canton of Zug, the expansion of the National Test Institute for Cybersecurity (NTC) enters the next stage. The NTC tests the cybersecurity of digital products and networked infrastructures. The Test Institute thus takes on an important role in efforts to strengthen Switzerland's cybersecurity and its independence. In Tobias Castagna, the NTC has hired a cybersecurity expert who will be responsible for the development and management of the testing experts. A permanent pool of around 30 cybersecurity specialists is to be established by 2025.
